**APPLYING FOR MEMBERSHIP TO THE
AUSTRALIAN GUILD OF SCREEN COMPOSERS LIMITED ("AGSC") (ACN 116 469 713)**

1. AGSC MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

A person shall be eligible for membership if a person:

- 1.1 has completed and submitted an application for membership in the form prescribed by the AGSC; and
- 1.2 has paid any membership fee payable (such fee to be returned if an application is unsuccessful); and
- 1.3 is a screen composer who:
 - (a) is a citizen of Australia or who is domiciled or resident in Australia; and
 - (b) has two screen credits for film music composition; and
- 1.4 is a person who has a demonstrated interest in the objects of the AGSC that are:
 - (a) To promote and protect the legal, economic and moral rights and interests of Australian screen composers;
 - (b) To represent the interests of Australian screen composers and their works;
 - (c) To develop and promote employment opportunities for Australian screen composers;
 - (d) To promote the dissemination of the works of Australian screen composers through publishing, recording, broadcasting, screen, television, the concert hall and other media;
 - (e) To encourage the development of Australian music composition and creativity on screen and to collect and disseminate information relating to music on screen;
 - (f) To promote the role of Australian music in screen productions;
 - (g) To undertake educational initiatives to promote and assist the training of Australian screen composers;
 - (h) To increase the profile (heighten awareness) of Australian screen composers amongst the industry as well as the general public;
 - (i) To print and publish such newsletters, periodicals, books, leaflets and other documents and to take such other steps as may be desirable for the promotion of and for the purposes of the objects of the AGSC;
 - (j) To appoint, retain, employ, remove or suspend such employees as may be necessary or convenient for the purposes of the AGSC;
 - (k) To do all such things as may be incidental to or conducive to the attainment of the objects of the Company, and to exercise the power of the AGSC; and
- 1.5 is approved for membership by a two-thirds majority of the Board.

2. ASSOCIATES AND FRIENDS OF THE AGSC

Associates and Friends of the AGSC who do not comply with the above conditions of membership may nevertheless support and participate in functions of the AGSC upon such terms as are determined by the Board.

3. CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

A person ceases to be a Member in the following circumstances:

- 3.1 if the person dies;
- 3.2 if by giving one month's notice in writing to the Secretary, the person resigns his/her membership of the AGSC (subject to payment of any amount payable to the AGSC including any unpaid membership fees or as a result of the AGSC winding up);
- 3.3 if the subscription of a member remains unpaid for a period of 3 calendar months after it becomes due; or
- 3.4 if the Board resolves that the person's membership shall cease.
